HCBS = Home and Community Based Services Waiver (age 5 and up.) A converted score of 35 or greater is needed on the annual screening instrument called "BASIS". Recipients of HCBS must also be eligible Medicaid beneficiaries.

MR/DD = Mental Retardation/Developmental Disability

SGF = State General Funds (as available, subject to annual appropriation by state legislature).

Other = May include school district funding (for persons age 18 – 21 who have not yet exited the school system); Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) funding; charitable foundations; other funding not listed.

*Targeted Case Management is required for any individual who accesses a paid service.

Available funding is subject to change annually.

At the present time, persons should expect to be wait-listed for service funding.
